

## June 8 -10, 2018 ~ "COWBOY" Mountain Trail Challenge ~ Class List & Description

<b>COWBOY DIVISION</b> - courses designed with obstacles encountered on mountain trails, a working ranch, or trail competition.		
Classes 1-6 are 3-day classes whereby each entrant will have one run each day. Scores from each day will be accumulated to determine final placing.		
1	<b>OPEN COWBOY</b> - Open to all exhibitors.	\$150
2	<b>AMATEUR COWBOY</b> - Exhibitors that engage in this activity as a pastime, rather than a profession. This class is NOT for exhibitors who have taken remuneration for training, instruction, clinics, etc...	\$150
3	<b>BUCKAROO (Timed &amp; Judged)</b> - Exhibitors are judged for accuracy of execution - completed in the quickest amount of time.	\$100
4	<b>INTERMEDIATE COWBOY</b> - Horse and Exhibitor has some degree of skill or competence that exceeds novice skill set, but not yet ready for amateur/open. Cannot have won more than 2 first place awards on the Cowboy Course at the Cowboy Mountain Trail Challenge or in the Silverado Arena at Oregon Horse Center Mountain Trail events.	\$120
5	<b>NOVICE RANCH HAND</b> - Exhibitor has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event. Cannot have won more than one first place awards on the Cowboy Course at the Cowboy Mountain Trail Challenge or in the Silverado Arena at Oregon Horse Center Mountain Trail events.	\$120
6	<b>NOVICE RANCH HORSE</b> - Horse has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event. Cannot have won more than one first place awards on the Cowboy Course at the Cowboy Mountain Trail Challenge or in the Silverado Arena at Oregon Horse Center Mountain Trail events.	\$120
<b>COWBOY CLASS LIST</b> - courses designed with obstacles encountered on mountain trails, working ranch, or trail competition.		
F	S	<b>Individual classes that can be entered separately each day using the corresponding class number.</b>
7		<b>MAIDEN RANCH HORSE</b> – has not won a first place award in any trail type class

12		<b>ALL AROUND RANCH HAND (Arena Work)</b> - For this class you <b>must</b> also be entered in the <i>Open or Amateur</i> and the <i>Timed &amp; Judged</i> classes to be eligible for the All Around Horsemanship title. The same horse/rider combination has to be used for all three classes. (If you ride in both the Open & Amateur classes you will need to designate prior to the first class, on the first day which class you want to use towards all around.) <b>COWPOKE Class List</b> - courses designed with beginner and novice level obstacles encountered on mountain trails, a working ranch, or trail competition. Youth & Adult <b>High Point Buckles</b> for the horse/rider combination earning the most points. If you show more than one horse, you must designate the horse that will be ridden for points. This must be done prior to the start of the show (a form will be available in the show office). <b>If the exhibitor shows multiple horses and does not identify which horse will earn points, no points will be earned. 4H members - classes ½ price. ~ Professionals or horse/rider combinations (excluding youth riders age 10 &amp; under) that have placed first more than 6 times in any outdoor competitive trail type competition cannot ride in the Cowpoke Classes. ~</b>
